 - o Living in or from a community similar to City Heights.

- Ability to work as part of team in a fast paced, dynamic work environment.

 - Segal Educational Award:
 - Approximately \$5,730 upon completion of 12-month service contract or approximately \$1,500 end of service stipend.
 - Potential for Student Loan Deferment.
