NOTE: Your team is encouraged to complete and return this form ASAP to guarantee space in UCSD housing. Forms can be submitted in advance of payment, with payment submitted no later than May 16th, 2008.

HOUSING INFORMATION

Teams will be housed in UCSD's Earl Warren Residence Halls and Warren Apartments, which are located near the Canyonview Pool where the competition's underwater events will take place. (See <http://maps.ucsd.edu/Viewer.htm?Map=Visitor> for a map of campus.) Residence halls consist of 4 single and 2 double occupancy rooms and a shared bathroom and living room area. Apartments consist of 2 double occupancy rooms and a shared bathroom, kitchen, and living room area. For the floor plans of both the residence halls and the apartments, see <http://hds.ucsd.edu/warren/>

NOTE: UCSD policy requires that residence halls and apartments house students of the same gender **ONLY**. There will be no mixing of genders in either the residence halls or the apartments. See the housing registration form located at the end of this document for more information.

Teams will be housed on a first-come, first-serve basis. Parents, siblings, or spouses ***servicing as chaperones*** are also welcome to reside on campus. Be sure to include these individuals on the housing registration form located at the end of this document.

PRICING

Your team is responsible for covering housing costs.

The rate per person for the four-night stay (Wednesday, June 25th – Saturday, June 28th nights) is \$175. This rate includes:

- The following meals:
 - Dinner on Wednesday, June 25th
 - Breakfast Thursday, June 26th – Sunday, June 29th
 - Dinner on Friday, June 27th
- Linens but **NOT** towels
- Parking permits (see below for more information)

MEALS PROVIDED BY THE MATE CENTER

The MATE Center will provide the following meals for the student team members, instructors, and mentors:

- Lunches on each day of the competition (Thursday, June 26th – Saturday, June 28th)
- Kick-off reception being held at the Birch Aquarium at Scripps Institution of Oceanography the evening of Thursday, June 26th
- Awards banquet being held at the UCSD Price Center the evening of Saturday, June 28th

Parents, siblings, spouses, cheerleaders, and other non-team members traveling with the team are welcome to purchase tickets for the kick-off reception and awards banquet. Information on pricing and how to purchase tickets will be circulated in April.

CHECK-IN/CHECK-OUT

Check-in date/time: Wednesday, June 25th, 7:30am – midnight

Check-out date/time: Sunday, June 29th, 11am

EARLY ARRIVALS/LATE DEPARTURES

Teams can arrive up to two days early and/or depart up to two days late. The rate is \$30 per person per day. Meals are **NOT** included.

Make sure to complete the EARLY ARRIVAL/LATE DEPARTURE portion of the housing form located at the end of this document if your team is interested.

KEYS

- For security purposes, all keys and cards unaccounted for will be considered lost and lock change procedures will begin immediately.
- Participants will be charged \$100.00 for any lock change. (Key-card replacement fee is \$2.00 per card where applicable).
- If, after check-out, excessive cleaning is necessary by UCSD personnel, UCSD will impose a cleaning fee. Participants will be charged this fee.

PARKING

Parking permits for STUDENT ONLY lots are included with housing. Limit is 1 permit per person. Use the housing registration form located at the end of this document to request parking permits for participants residing on-campus ONLY. Parking permits for participants residing off-campus are available; see the information that follows for how and where to purchase.

- The cost of parking is included in the housing rate for all participants residing in campus housing. Parking permits for on-campus participants are designated as “S.”
- “S” parking permits are only valid in “S” marked YELLOW SPACES.
- Permit must be displayed face up on the driver’s side of the dashboard
- The university does not guarantee the availability of “S” spaces within close proximity of participants’ housing or activities.
- Off-campus participants may purchase a parking permit at the Warren Conference Service Desk or at one of the Information Booths. The tentative 2008 rates are as follows: \$6.00/day, \$29.50/week, or \$59.00/month. Rates are subject to change annually. (**Subject to change**)
- Currently, permits are required five (5) days a week, Monday - Friday, from 7:00am - 11:00pm. Permits are not required on the weekends, but subject to change.
- Illegally parked vehicles may be issued a parking ticket, especially if parked in “Reserved,” “Handicapped,” “Reserved for Vanpool Vehicles,” or “Yard Permit Required” spaces.
- UCSD will not be liable for parking tickets or fines imposed on the participants.

INTERNET ACCESS

IP addresses are available for \$10 per person and can be purchased at the Warren Conference Service Desk.

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- UCSD is a non-smoking facility. No smoking is permitted in any indoor area, or within 20 feet of the main entrance or exit to any facility owned or leased by UCSD.
- UCSD is NOT responsible for lost or stolen articles.
- Participants will be charged for any damage to facilities or items missing from UCSD’s property.

- Participants' use UCSD facilities and property by permission of the Regents of the University of California. Failure to observe rules or irresponsible or unacceptable behavior may be grounds to withdraw permission.

HOTELS
