Southern California ROV Flyoff Information

- 1. Tech Report Due Date – Friday April 17th midnight. All reports must be 2M bytes or less. Email to sfraser@lbcc.edu We are providing the regional a little longer to prepare their report.**
- 2. Parking – Download the parking pass provided on the MATE website and print it IN COLOR – using YELLOW paper. You may print as many of these passes as needed. Parking is in the large lot on the South West corner of Carson Street and Clark Avenue**
- 3. Check in – We will have team check-in running by 8:30am on 5/2/09.**
- 4. Poster Displays will be set up in room B101 on the north side of Carson Street. Posters must be set up by 10:30am**
- 5. Engineering evaluations will take place in room B204. This room is on the 2nd floor and on the south east corner of the building. There is an elevator on the north east corner of the building.**
- 6. There will only be ONE run at the task per team. Time slots are assigned and teams must be ready when assigned. There will be no swapping of time slots. Come prepared to take the first time slot if so assigned.**
- 7. Lunch will be served in B101 at noon and can be eaten on the grass just outside of the building. Lunch will be provided for the deck team and advisor.**

Check-In Information

The check-in table is on the north side of the pool area. We will need the names of the six deck team members at that time. The following people will be allowed on the competition deck during the team's scheduled time slot, the six member deck team, one advisor, one photographer. Name tags will be handed out identifying your team. When your team's assigned slot has completed, everyone associated with your team must leave the competition deck area. Please inform those that you bring (parents, friends, family, etc) that there will be no exceptions to this rule and violations will cause your team to forfeit the pool points. The area around the control stations is limited in space and this is for safety reasons.

At check-in, your team will be assigned a Long Beach City College student who will be acting as your guide and go-to person for the competition. They will know the way around and help guide your team from place to place to ensure that you make it to where you are going on time.
