1. Check deployment area		 Trip hazards: cables, hoses laying on the ground Uneven - unstable ground Unsecured equipment 	 Move and store any loose cables or hoses Mark or close off unstable areas, set up railing Tie down any loose equipment
2. Move ROV onto launch platform		 Slipping or falling into water or on ground Hypothermia Impacts from bumps & scratches Low visibility environment 	 Use 3 points of contact Multilayer clothing Safety boots and gloves Reflective floatation vest
3. Place ROV in water		 Falling into water Unstable surface Tether on deck trip hazard 	 Three points of contact Hand feed tether into water Keep all tether slack neatly coiled
4. Recover ROV		 Slipping or falling into water or on ground Hypothermia Impacts from bumps & scratches Low visibility environment 	 Use 3 points of contact Multilayer clothing Safety boots and gloves Reflective floatation vest
